Welcome to the Showcase of Dogs and 2008 U-Fli Championship Tournament. We have 24 teams competing in the dream team challenge, 23 singles and 6 pairs competing in the singles and pairs championship on Friday, 36 teams competing in the championship, 41 teams competing in the standard tournament on Saturday and 51 teams competing in the standard tournament on Sunday. This will be a three ring tournament. We have Randy Kenzie, Elizabeth Hudson and Brian Kauk as our full time judges. We will have several judges stepping in to provide them relief. Our U-Fli representative will be Melanie McAvoy.

Please make sure that all dogs and participants are registered with U-FLI prior to the Tournament. Dogs and participants not registered will be ineligible to play. In accordance with U-FLI Rules and Regulations, ALL dogs desiring to jump less than the maximum height of 12" are required to measure. Only dogs that are at least one year of age and have a RUN are eligible to be measured. Any dog that is not measured will default to the maximum jump height of 12". If your dog has already measured at a U-FLI tournament, it need not measure again. Please refer to the U-FLI Rules and Regulations for more information. Important things to know:

- Crating will be inside the D wing and in the amphitheater. The following link is a floor plan of the Agricenter: <http://www.agricenter.org/expofloorplans.html>  
The crating area is very limited. It may be necessary to stack crates, please plan ahead. It is our intention to provide approximately 96 s.f. (8' x 12') of crating space per team. Clubs with multiple teams will be allotted additional space based on the number of teams entered.
- Fetchin' Frenzi and U-FLI are not responsible for anything lost or stolen.

- The showcase committee will be charging admission at the gates. You can pick up wrist bands at check in for your team members. These wrist bands will gain you access to the show for the entire weekend. You can download an admission pass from our website that will gain you access to the show on Friday and Saturday until 10 am without a wrist band.
- Parking passes will not be given. You will be required to pay \$3 per day to park. You will be allowed each day before the event begins and after the event ends to load and unload next to the building. Please be considerate of your time because we have several teams and other exhibitors in other sports loading and unloading. Please be mindful of the parking rules established by the showcase committee. They will tow vehicles left in loading and unloading areas.
- We will not be stopping for lunch. The show will have several food vendors on-site.
