Welcome to the Showcase of Dogs and 2009 Barking In Memphis Flyball Tournament. We have 16 teams competing in standard competition on Saturday and Sunday. We have singles and pairs on Friday night from 5 pm- 7pm and mixed throughout Saturday racing. No singles and pairs on Sunday. This will be a one ring tournament. Tim Mulrooney will be our head judge and Val Rogalla will be our U-Fli representative.

Please note:

On October 6th, the Showcase of Dogs board rearranged the entire show. The flyball lanes and crating have moved from the dome and D wing to the west pavilion. Crating will be isolated with rod and drapes but will be in the same room as racing.

Please make sure that all dogs and participants are registered with U-FLI prior to the Tournament. Dogs and participants not registered will be ineligible to play. In accordance with U-FLI Rules and Regulations, ALL dogs desiring to jump less than the maximum height of 12" are required to measure. Only dogs that are at least one year of age and have a RUN are eligible to be measured. Any dog that is not measured will default to the maximum jump height of 12". If your dog has already measured at a U-FLI tournament, it need not measure again. Please refer to the U-FLI Rules and Regulations for more information. Important things to know:

- Crating will be inside the west pavilion. No crating in the amphitheater or the d wing this year. The following link is a floor plan of the Agricenter:

The crating area is very limited. It may be necessary to stack crates, please plan ahead. It is our intention to provide approximately 96 s.f. (8' x 12') of crating space per team. Clubs with multiple teams will be allotted additional space based on the number of teams entered.
- Fetchin' Frenzi and U-FLI are not responsible for anything lost or stolen.

- The showcase committee will be charging admission at the gates. You can pick up wrist bands at check in for your team members. These wrist bands will gain you access to the show for the entire weekend. You can download an admission pass from our website that will gain you access to the show on Saturday morning until 10 am without a wrist band.
- Parking passes will not be given. You will be required to pay to park. You will be allowed each day before the event begins and after the event ends to load and unload next to the building. Please be considerate of your time because we have several teams and other exhibitors in other sports loading and unloading. Please be mindful of the parking rules established by the showcase committee. They will tow vehicles left in loading and unloading areas.
- We should have a lunch break each day. The show will have several food vendors on-site.

Volunteers: If you see a ring position needing a volunteer and you have a few minutes, please step in and work the race. Several teams have offered to help, we are very thankful!
